Debra Nestel is Professor of Simulation Education in Healthcare, Monash University, Australia and has worked at the University of Hong Kong and Imperial College London. Debra is program lead for the Masters of Surgical Education (Department of Surgery, University of Melbourne and Royal Australasian College of Surgeons) and the Masters of Health Professions Education (Monash University). She is an honorary professorial fellow in the Departments of Surgery at the University of Melbourne and Imperial College, London. Debra is a Board Member of Simulation Australia and Chair of the Research Committee of the U.S. based Society for Simulation in Healthcare. In Australia, she leads a national program for simulation educators – NHET-Sim (www.nhet-sim.edu.au) and a state-based network in simulated patient methodology (www.vspn.edu.au). Debra has published over 140 peer reviewed papers in health professions education and recently published a book simulated patient methodology.
