MSC job description for Student Outreach Advisory Group

The Medical and Dental Schools Council are recruiting students from across the UK to support their outreach programme. The Student Outreach Advisory Group will provide advice and guidance to the wider programme, ensuring that the student voice is heard.

We welcome applications from medicine and dentistry students from England, Wales, Scotland, and Northern Ireland who are studying on standard entry courses, graduate entry courses, and Foundation/Gateway courses. Applicants should be in the first, second or third year of their degree (or Year 0 of a gateway or Foundation course).

We welcome applicants from all backgrounds including people who are from a minoritised ethnic background, people from the LGBTQ+ community, people with a disability, people with caring responsibilities, and people of all faiths and none.

The Student Outreach Advisory Group will:

- Support the Medical and Dental Schools Councils to widen access to medicine and dentistry
- Promote and enhance widening participation across UK medical and dental schools
- Provide student perspective to inform the Medical and Dental Schools outreach programme
- Have key input into strategic direction of student generated content for [Studying Healthcare](#)
- Advise on future strategy and further development of this workstream
- Identify new opportunities for student involvement in outreach
- Work with MSC and DSC communications team to identify and create content for distribution across social media platforms

Members of the group will be expected to attend up to four meetings per academic year and work with the communications team to create content for use across social media platforms.

Members of the group will be paid to attend and prepare for the meetings. It is anticipated there would be up to 8 hours of work. The hourly rate is £13.85. Members will also be paid for any social media content they create.
